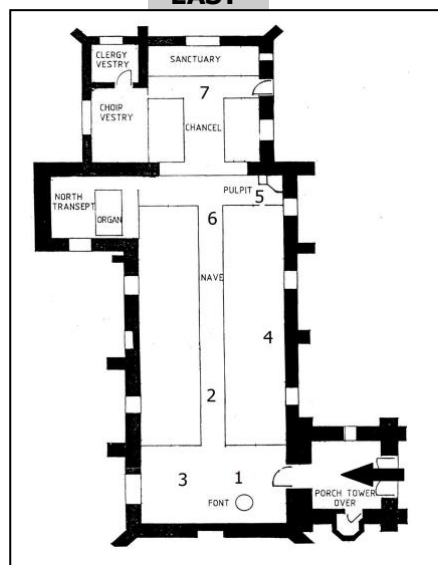
3 FLOWERS

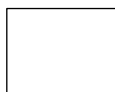


5 PULPIT

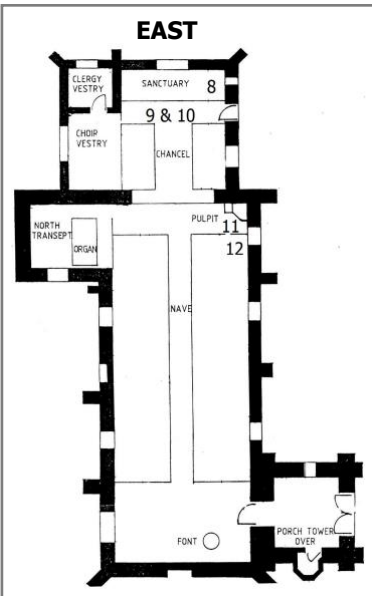

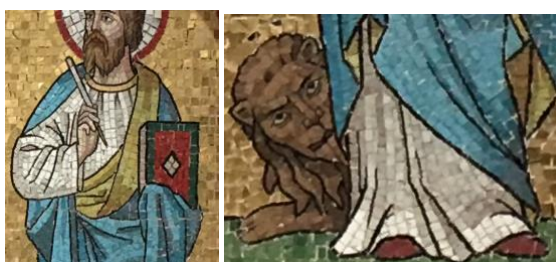

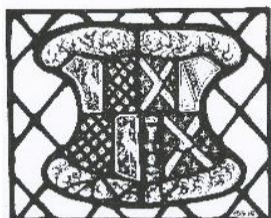

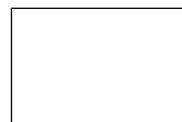

14 SPIRE

Before you leave, just sit quietly, and think about what you have seen.

As you do leave, you will notice that the Spire of the church is covered with wooden tiles made from oak, which are known as shingles. The shingles become damaged by the wind, sun, and rain, meaning that they need replacing from time to time, most recently in 2007. To help with the expense, people were invited to pay for a tile and put their name on its back before it was put in place. You can see framed examples of these tiles on the wall to the right of the door on the way out.
